KOI FISH

The Lord gave me a vision one night of a Koi fish. It was stunning, but I did not understand until I did a little study on Koi fish. Don't take what the Lord shows or tells you lightly. Steward it well.

The size of the Koi fish highly correlates with the challenges it faces in its environment. If you put this little swimmer in a fish bowl and feed him his food, he will stay about the size of a goldfish. Put him in a pond where he has to struggle and fend for himself, and he can grow to an average of 3 1/2 feet, with many much larger than that, of course.

YOU GROW IN THE STRUGGLE. Look back on your life, and ask yourself, "When were my most significant times of deepening maturity? When did I learn the most – about God and about myself?" As long as all is easy swimming, and the "food" is just being dropped in to you, you don't have to learn, to stretch, and most of all, to actively and desperately depend on God. I'd be willing to bet that as you review the seasons of your life, those times when you didn't believe you had all the answers were the most fertile growth periods. Valleys always display greener grass than the mountains.

Consider it nothing but joy, my brothers and sisters, whenever you fall into various trials. Be assured that the testing of your faith [through experience] produces endurance [leading to spiritual maturity, and inner peace]. And let endurance have its perfect result and do a thorough work, so that you may be perfect and completely developed [in your faith], lacking in nothing. (James 1: 2-4, The Amplified Bible)

I don't know about you, but I want to rush on out of adversity. "Lord, deliver me! Change these circumstances! Make it stop!" Sometimes God says, "No, I choose to deliver you in them, just like Daniel in the Bible. I want you to understand as never before My faithfulness.
