As we grow that may seem like a lot for a small group of people to do, but it's Holy Spirit who pours out the grace and love for them all. That is the only way we will have it. Without Holy Spirit, we might as well stop because it will lead to exhaustion. I say this for us all. No matter what you do, we all need this discipline of making time with Him our utmost priority. We can do nothing with out Him.

MARCH DEVO

"Heal the sick, raise the dead, cure those with leprosy, and cast out demons. Give as freely as you have received! Matthew 10:8
