Since 2018, when this journey first began in a simple soup kitchen, we have watched God expand the work far beyond anything we could have imagined—into youth programs, mobile mentoring, and ongoing support for families across Northeast Louisiana. Yet through all that growth, one truth has become unmistakable: the harvest is abundant, but the laborers are still far too few.

Each week we encounter children surrounded by neglect, violence, drugs, and abuse. Many are growing up in environments where chaos is normal, stability is scarce, and love feels uncertain. They are carrying trauma, fear, and confusion far beyond their years. When there are not enough people willing to disciple and guide them while they are young, the world is more than willing to step in—shaping their identity, numbing their pain, and normalizing destruction. And when that happens, the need does not go away; it only becomes harder to address later in life.

This is not a call to NELA Youth alone—it is a call to the entire Body of Christ. God has given each of us unique gifts, talents, and callings, and when those gifts are brought together, they create lasting Kingdom impact. Sometimes that means allowing ourselves to be stretched—stepping outside familiar routines, letting go of rigid expectations, and creating space to truly meet people where they are. Ministry was never meant to be confined within four walls; it was meant to move into broken places with love, humility, and action.

Our community does not need perfect people—just willing ones. Presence matters. Compassion matters. And even one small step of obedience can make a profound difference in a young person's life.

The fields are ready, the opportunities are before us, and the impact reaches far beyond what we can see. We pray for laborers—and we warmly invite you to be one.
